- > Cost: \$200 for the camp. You can pay on the first day of camp. The camp is June 5 through July 21.
- First week June 5-8 is 1- pm in the gym.
- > Times for rest of summer will vary but will be Monday-Thursday.
- With camp, you also get to participate in the summer leagues that run from June 4 through July 21. We play Monday through Thursday afternoon and nights. Our summer program does not interfere with Diamond Bar High School summer school. Camp is required to play in summer leagues and summer practices. For the price, this is almost two months of basketball.
- All student-athletes must be cleared before they can participate in any summer activities. Please visit <a href="www.athleticclearance.com">www.athleticclearance.com</a> to start the registration process. All paperwork should be submitted a week before the summer activities start in order to be processed in time.
- For all players the camp will serve as a chance to prepare for tryouts. The tryouts for the regular season are June 5-8 and again in November in the gym. Camp is not required to tryout but you must be athletically cleared.
- > If you cannot make the first week of camp, please come the second week and get involved as soon as possible. The camp will work on the fundamentals of basketball as well as our team fundamentals such as offenses and defenses.
- > The program will be run by Head Varsity Coach Tony McCabe (39 years coaching high school and college basketball) and the current DBHS Girls' Basketball staff.
- All camp times will not conflict with morning summer school at Diamond Bar High School. You can play other sports at Diamond Bar High School and all sports will work with you so that you can participate in all the other summer programs that you wish.
