

Dear Brahma Parent and Student:

The beginning of the school year is just around the corner. With that in mind, registration for fall classes begins on Monday, July 10, and runs through Friday, August 4. We ask that you come 20 minutes before your scheduled appointment time to fill out important paperwork. If you do not have an appointment call Diamond Bar High School at (909) 594-1405 immediately to schedule your registration appointment.

After your scheduled appointment with your Grade Level Coordinator (GLC) you will be able to purchase many of your needs for the school year including an Activity Card, Yearbook, Rodeo Round-up tickets, optional PE clothes, etc. Our computerized ID system will print a student picture ID and bar code instantly. We accept payment with **VISA, MASTER CARD, DISCOVER CARD, AM EXP, CASH AND CHECKS** for your convenience.

The Activity Card offers many savings throughout the school year including free student admission to league home and away sporting events, and discounts on the Yearbook, school dances, and much more! Your Activity Card savings can add up to as much as \$300 per year. The Activity Card sells for \$45.00. We are offering the Activity Card and Taurus (ALL COLOR yearbook) at a combined price of \$140.00, for a savings of \$10. If purchased separate from the Activity Card, your Yearbook price will be \$105.00. **THE LAST DAY TO PURCHASE A YEARBOOK IS NOVEMBER 3, 2017.** If you are interested in purchasing a Senior Ad, contact the yearbook advisor

Fave's Place (The Student Store) will be open during registration with limited hours for you to purchase sweat shirts, sweat pants, Brahma memorabilia and spirit items, and other optional school supplies. Come check out all of our merchandise. You may use your VISA, MASTER CARD, AMEX CARD OR DISCOVER CARD in our student store as well. Though we do not require students to purchase DBHS P.E. clothes, they are available for purchase in the student store (approximately \$25) if students choose to buy them.

A few facts that will make your student's registration easier:

- **Reminder: Your appointment time is when you meet with your GLC, not when you arrive to fill out forms. Allow 20 minutes before your scheduled appointment time and plan on one hour to conclude all of your responsibilities.**
- Maps will be posted at the front gate to direct you.
- Be sure to begin at Station #1 first and fill out your medical records, questionnaires and other important forms. Allow 20 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment for this purpose.
- After completing all forms you will be directed to your GLC for class scheduling.
- After visiting your GLC proceed to the **USB STATION**. Carefully review and fill out the reverse side of this letter and bring it with you.
- Student store purchases are processed separately from USB purchases, therefore, if choose to purchase PE clothes or other merchandise from our student store be sure to bring more than one check.
- If you would like to purchase P.E. clothing it is recommended that you purchase PE clothes prior to the start of school.
- Every student will have his/her picture taken for an Activity or ID Card. The Activity Card has a different look than the ID Card but contains the same bar code information. Remember, the ID Card offers no savings, discounts or benefits.
- **If you want to be a part of Renaissance, you must bring your last semester's report card!**
